CLASSES

- **Course #3009: “History of Women in Religion” — Rev. Dr. Mary Smith, Instructor**
Students will gain a deeper understanding of the historical significance of women in the Old and New Testament. They will gain practical application to modern day situations. Students will be empowered to be leaders in their current denominations, as well as empower other women to take a more active role in the church leadership and work.
- **Course #7015: “Growing the Church through the Sunday School” — Rev. Tijuanna Williams, Instructor**
Students will explore the revitalizing of the Sunday School as a strategy for church growth. Models and methods for Sunday School revitalization will be studied to enhance church growth. This class is designed to engage students in the teachings of Christ and to use these foundational truths to offer individuals change, whereby God will be able to draw them into the Church house.
- **Course #8025: “The Church’s Response to Human Needs through Community Action” — Rev. Dr. Emma Valentine, Instructor**
Students will be encouraged to reclaim the heritage of their traditional responsibilities in aiding and engaging their rich culture in helping the least, lost, and last, to strengthen the relationship among churches within the Association, and discover how to respond as a community of churches to various human needs. The students will be empowered to affirm in this 21st century, the call to affirm the kingdom of God both present and future, both societal and individual, relating to various "stigma," and relating to various forms of mental illness. In addition, I hope to move students beyond spiritual bankruptcy into a place of community action.
- **Course #8055: “The Church’s Response to the Twenty-First Century” — Dr. Ellsworth Weaver, Instructor**
Students will be helped to recognize that people may and do begin their spiritual journeys from many starting points, but truth ultimately converges at one door, one path, and one life--Jesus Christ. Students will be empowered in knowing that the last thing we need is a postmodern church, but a church for postmodern people who will engage with the culture to gain a yearning for the gospel.
- **Course #9923: “Organizing The Church for Ministry and Mission” — Dr. Barbara Smith Price, Instructor**
Students will examine the purpose and goals of the church and look at new methods of ministry through intentional programs and organizational structures that will effectively meet the changing needs of today. Students will be exposed to new ways of thinking about Missions and services, and together create innovative ways to address the changing needs in a global society.
