

LITANY OF UNITY

“Encouraging, Equipping and Empowering the Body of Christ for Kingdom Purposes”

(Ephesians 4:1-3, 6-11, 32; Psalm 133:1; Acts 4:32; Romans 15:5-6)

Leader: Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, being diligent to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
